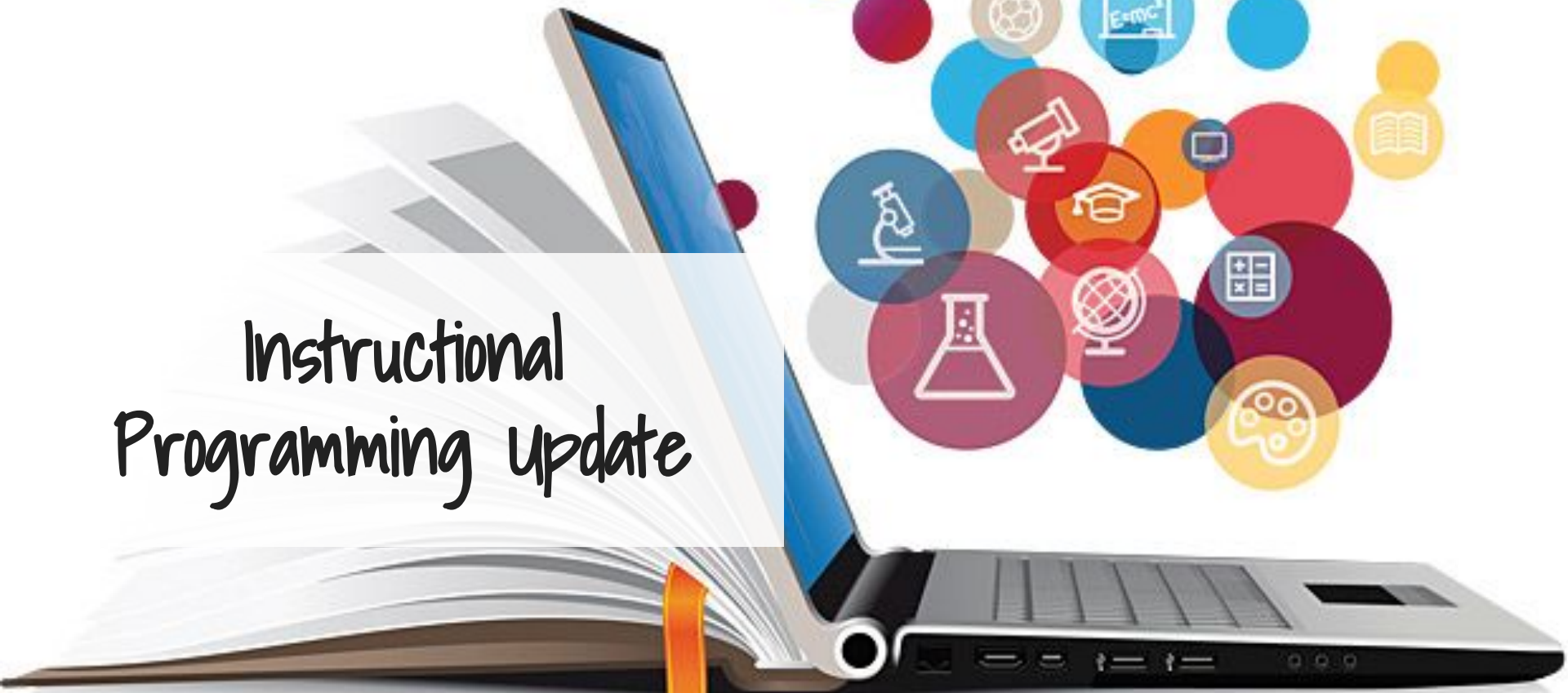

DOH/PDE Guidance System

DoH/PDE will be issued a [new guidance system](#) on August 11, 2020. The uses metrics (i.e., number of cases and test positivity rate) to designate each county as having low, moderate, or substantial COVID transmission.

Based on the COVID transmission designation, DoH/PDE will recommend (not order) the type of instruction schools should be providing:

- **Low transmission:** Face-to-Face or Hybrid
- **Moderate transmission:** Hybrid or all Virtual
- **Substantial transmission:** All Virtual

DoH will issued the initial transmission data (as well as last week's designation) for each county and will subsequently issue the next designation each following Monday. It will also be recommended that schools wait for 2 consecutive weeks of the same designation prior to considering changing the type of instruction.

If fewer than 10 new cases are reported in a county in the most recent 7-day reporting period, the county will automatically qualify as exhibiting a low level of community transmission.
