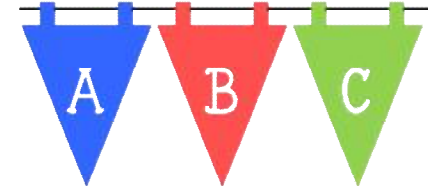

Assignment Book: Students will receive an assignment book and are expected to write assignments daily. Please check it each night.

G

Gym on Day 4. Remember to wear sneakers!

M

Math: We use Everyday Math. Home Links will be assigned daily for homework. Please check my teacher webpage to access the EDM website.

B

Binders: Your child will need a 1 inch binder with 3 separate binder folders. The first folder will contain their homework and parent informational sheets, the second folder will be for graded papers, and the third folder will be for miscellaneous papers done in class. Please help your child keep their binder organized!

Homework: Daily homework typically includes Reading 20 minutes and a math sheet. Make sure you are also studying for any upcoming tests or quizzes!
