## **Policy Committee Meeting**

August 17, 2020 (via Zoom)

The minutes from the Policy Meeting of <u>June 15</u>, <u>2020 Meeting Minutes</u> (Attachment A) were approved.

1. Policy 103: Discrimination/Title IX Sexual Harrassment Affecting Students- reviewed and discussed the new Title IX policy, as a result of revisions to Title IX Regulations, which went into effect on August 14, 2020. The new investigatory process mandated by the Title IX revisions will extend the disciplinary process for students and in particular the expulsion process. Title IX regulations will supersede all other district disciplinary policy. As such, the expulsion policy will need to be updated to reflect the new mandates under Title IX and the timeline. The committee agreed that the District will be using the "preponderance of evidence" standard. It is also important to note that the new regulations require that all employees, contractors and regular volunteers of the District are to be considered "responsible employees" with an obligation to report all Title IX violations to the Title IX Coordinator. UPSD has contracted with Institutional Compliance Solutions (ICS) to develop a Title IX University, containing Title IX training for the District's Title IX Team. This training meets the official "certification" qualifications, as defined by the U.S. Department of Education. Additionally, the District's Title IX Team attended training offered by ATIXA and Fox and Rothschild. All employees and contractors of the District are required to complete mandatory Title IX training, via Safe Schools by 9/31/20. The changes to the Title IX regulations require the District to repeal and replace several policies.
